Dealing with Logins, Passwords, and Profiles

Much of our website provides information to the public and is easily accessible to everyone without extra effort. However, some parts, such as course registrations, require you to identify yourself.

Our website uses your email address as your primary identification. It is designed to connect one person with each unique email address. It uses that email address to communicate with that person.

Any part of our system that requires that you identify yourself will require you to login. This identifies you to the system.

If you try to login to the site and cannot get your password to work, or if you forgot your password, use the *Forgot Password* sequence to set a new password. This can be found under the Login button:



in the popup window that is produced:




When you click on Forgot Password you will be prompted for your email address, which is your primary identifier on the system:



Enter your email address. If you are not a robot, click the *I'm not a robot* checkbox, and then click on *Submit*.

If the email address is known to the system an email will be sent to that address with a link that enables you to set the password for that account. If you enter a totally new email address you will see an error message like this:

RESET PASSWORD



This tells you the system has never encountered this email address before and you cannot use it to login.

Normal Login

The above sequence will work if you are a current member, lapsed member, or only an email new subscriber.

Once you know your password you can login to the system by clicking *Log* in and filling in your email address and password:



After filling in your info, click the *Log in* button in the pop-up window, but before you do, check off *Remember me* if you are using your private computer and want the system to remember your account info.

Once you are logged in, the login location will reflect your name:



Your Profile

Your profile is a summary of everything the system knows about you. You get to it by clicking on your name after you have logged in and clicking on *View Profile*:



This will produce a page with multiple tabs with the first tab already selected:

If you want to fill in any details or edit what is shown, click on *Edit Profile*. **Note that this is where you can change your account's email address when you get a new one!**

Note also that you can click on the other tabs (Email subscriptions, My event registrations, Invoices and payments, and Donations) to see those details. This is handy for checking what courses you have registered for.

Once you have logged in you can register for courses and the system will already know who you are so it should not prompt you for this information again.

Sharing one email address

If you are used to sharing an email address with two or more people you need to make a change when using our site. Because our site is designed around one person per email address you need to make each person's login email address unique.


One way to do that is to obtain a free email address for the second (or third) person from another provider and use that to identify this person on our site.

However, if you do not want to do that, you can try this trick instead. When using your current email address on our site, add a plus sign and one person's name to the email. For example, if John and Jane Doe share the email jjdoe@somewhere.com, one of them can create an account on our site using jjdoe+John@somewhere.com along with the name John Doe, and the other can use jjdoe+Jane@somewhere.com along with Jane Doe. This way each login is unique. But, because of a quirk in the email system, all email messages from our site for both accounts will go to jjdoe@somewhere.com and no additional email is needed.

Joining as a Member

Joining as a brand new member

If you have just arrived at our website and have not logged in, and you want to join as a member, click on the *Join Us/Renew* menu choice.



Here you start the multi-step process. Select the membership type that applies to you by clicking in the appropriate circle. Almost always that will be the first one, which is simply *Member*. Then click the *Next* button.

Note that if you click *Next* without selecting a membership type you will see:



and you will have to click *OK* there to continue.

Next you will see a place to enter your email address. This is what will become your unique identifier on our system. Enter the email address you want to use and then click the *I'm not a robot* box before clicking the *Next* button.

altogether using the *Cancel* button.

Next the system checks whether you are already known to it and if so it let's you know that you should login to your existing account. You may not realize you already have an account if all you did previously is sign up for email news or make a donation, but if your email address has been seen by the system before, you have an account!

So, because you have an account you need to login first and then pick up the joining process afterward. It may be easiest to cancel this process now and start over after logging into the site. See the instructions on logging in elsewhere in this guide if you need further help.

Assuming you have successfully logged in, we will pick up the joining process with the next step.



Finally, click *Next*.


The next step is where you decide how to pay for you membership.

Follow the




instructions. Click on *Pay Online* to pay now with a credit card or click on *Invoice Me* to have the system generate an invoice that you can print and mail into Senior College along with a bank check. Either will work but be aware your membership will not be complete until we receive your check and process it.

If you select to create an invoice you will now see this notice in your online profile:



If you click on *View/Pay Invoice* you can still pay the invoiced amount online at this point:

Renewing membership as an existing member

If you have an account on our site and have been a member in the past when you click on the *Join Us/Renew* menu choice yo will see a page that looks like this:

BECOME A SENIOR COLLEGE MEMBER

You must be at least 50 years old to become a Senior College member. Your annual membership fee supports our overall mission and makes you a member of our community. You, or your spouse/partner, must be a member to take our regular courses during the Fall, Winter and Spring semesters.

Our normal membership fee is \$25/year and runs from September 1st through August 31st of the following year.

If you are a member of another Maine Senior College you should pick that membership and indicate which other Senior College you are a member of. You do not have to pay for two memberships.

RENEWING YOUR MEMBERSHIP

If you are already a member of the Senior College for 2022-2023 you will need to renew your membership before you can register for 2023-2024 courses. You can renew online, in person or by mail any time during the 2023-2024 year. (*Call the office* to find out details of the **offline** methods.)

To renew online, first be sure you have logged into this website on the landing page. When you are logged in, when you come to this page you will see a yellow banner above which tells you that you are already a member and which has a link to meet to your member profile.

NOTE: If you do not see that banner either you are not a current member or you are not logged in.


When you click on *Edit your member profile* on that banner, you will be shown a lot of details about your membership. There should be a blue banner prompting you to renew your membership. Click on the blue RENEW banner to start the online renewal process.

Here you need to click on the link in the yellow banner notice to go to your account profile page:

Membership details




Of course, you will need to scroll down to see the remaining profile details, but the important part for renewing your membership is the blue button in the middle that says *Renew to Sunday, September 01,2024* (or something similar). Click on this button to start the membership renewal process. From here you can follow the steps in the process detailed above in the previous section of this guide.

You will be given a chance to update any of your profile details before clicking *Update and Next* to proceed to payment details.

Renewing with a coupon code

Each year instructors are given a discount code to use when renewing their membership which results in 100% discount (one year free membership). When you click on *Renew to Sunday, September 01,2024* (or similar) and see your profile details, this is the point you can enter your coupon code. The location is at the very bottom of your profile details and looks like this:



See the field labeled *Discount Code* at the very bottom? Just fill it in and then click *Update and Next*.
